Do's

Please follow all the guidelines for COVID-19 issued by WHO, Govt. of India, Govt. of Uttarakhand and various related Govt. Agencies.

Devotees should register themselves for e pass along with Covid negative RT PCR report ( test done 72 hours prior to the kumbh mela site visit ) and medical check up ( in prescribed format ) for travelling to Haridwar

Pilgrims are advised to to install aarogya Setu app

Use of mask / face cover is mandatory those not following the same will be penalised

Individual must maintain minimum distance of 6 feet in public places

Please follow COVID Appropriate Behaviours.

Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed this involves covering of nose and mouth while coughing and sneezing with a tissue handkerchief or flexed elbow and disposing off used tissue properly

Practice frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty

Use of alcohol based sanitizer can be done whenever possible

Self monitoring of health of all should be done and should report any illness to district or kumbh helpline

Keep Emergency Contact numbers handy at all times.

Use Bathing Ghats that are authorized by the Mela administration only and that are nearest to place of stay in the Mela area.

Inform the authorities if any unidentified or suspicious object/activity is found.

Follow the instructions given by the Mela Administration through PA System or any other modes.

Cooperate with the Departments involved in organizing the Mela

. Reach out to the Lost and Found Centres for loss of loved ones and belongings.

Don't carry too much baggage while travelling and avoid carrying valuables.

Don't use plastic bags in the city and mela area.

Don't defecate in the open.
